The SUD shall sell and deliver water service to the Applicant and the Applicant shall purchase, receive, and/or reserve service from the SUD in accordance with the bylaws and tariff of the SUD as amended from time to time by the Board of Directors of the SUD. Upon compliance with said policies, including payment of a Deposit, the Applicant qualifies as a Customer.

The Customer shall pay the SUD for service hereunder as determined by the SUD's tariff and upon the terms and conditions set forth therein. The Customer may request a copy of the SUD's tariff. A copy of *this* agreement shall be executed before service will be provided to the Customer.

All water shall be metered by meters to be furnished and installed by the SUD. The meter connection is for the sole use of the Customer and is to provide service to only one (l) dwelling or one (l) business. Extension of pipe(s) to transfer utility service from one property to another, to share, resell, or submeter water to any other persons, dwellings, businesses, or property, etc., is prohibited.

The SUD shall have the right to locate a water service meter and the pipe necessary to connect the meter on the Customer's property at a point to be chosen by the SUD, and shall have access to its property and equipment located upon Customer's premises at all reasonable and necessary times for any purpose connected with or in the furtherance of its business operations, and upon discontinuance of service the SUD shall have the right to remove any of its equipment from the Customer's property. The Customer shall install, at their own expense, any necessary service lines from the SUD's facilities and equipment to the point of use, including any customer service isolation valves, backflow prevention devices, clean-outs, and other equipment as may be specified by the SUD. The SUD shall also have access to the Customer's property for the purpose of inspecting for possible cross-connections, potential contamination hazards, illegal lead materials, and any other violations or possible violations of state and federal statutes and regulations relating to the federal Safe Drinking Water Act or Chapter 341 of the Texas Health & Safety Code or and the SUD's tariff and service policies.

The SUD is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution which could result from improper practices. This service agreement serves as notice to each customer of the restrictions which are in place to provide this protection. The SUD shall enforce these restrictions to ensure public health and welfare. The following undesirable practices are prohibited by state regulations:

- a. No direct connection between the public drinking water supply and a potential source of contamination is permitted. Potential sources of contamination shall be isolated from the public water system by an airgap or an appropriate backflow prevention assembly in accordance with state regulations.
- b. No cross-connection between the public drinking water supply and a private water system is permitted. These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be eliminated at the service connection by the proper installation of an airgap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention assembly and a service agreement must exist for annual inspection and testing by a certified backflow prevention device tester.
- c. No connection which allows condensing, cooling, or industrial process water to be returned to the public drinking water supply is permitted.
 - d. No pipe or pipefitting which contains more than 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of any public water supply.

- e. No pipe or pipefitting which contains more than 0.25% lead may be used for the installation or repair of any public water supply.
- f. No solder or flux which contains more than 0.2% lead may be used for the installation or repair of any plumbing in a residential or nonresidential facility providing water for human consumption and connected to a public drinking water supply system.

The SUD shall maintain a copy of this agreement as long as the Customer and/or premises is connected to the public water system. The Customer shall allow their property to be inspected for possible cross-connections, potential contamination hazards, and illegal lead materials. These inspections shall be conducted by the SUD or its designated agent prior to initiating service and periodically thereafter. The inspections shall be conducted during the SUD's normal business hours.

The SUD shall notify the Customer in writing of any cross-connections or other undesirable practices which have been identified during the initial or subsequent inspection. The Customer shall immediately correct any undesirable practice on their premises. The Member shall, at their expense, properly install, test, and maintain any backflow prevention device required by the SUD. Copies of all testing and maintenance records shall be provided to the SUD as required. Failure to comply with the terms of this service agreement shall cause the SUD to either terminate service or properly install, test, and maintain an appropriate backflow prevention device at the service connection. Any expenses associated with the enforcement of this agreement shall be billed to the Customer.

In the event the total water supply is insufficient to meet all the Customers, or in the event there is a shortage of water, the SUD may initiate the Emergency Rationing Program as specified in the SUD's Tariff. By execution of this agreement, the Customer hereby shall comply with the terms of said program.

By execution hereof, the Customer shall hold the SUD harmless from any and all claims for damages caused by service interruptions due to waterline breaks by utility or like contractors, tampering by other Customer/users of the SUD, normal failures of the system, or other events beyond the SUD's control. **Initials**

The Customer shall grant to the SUD permanent recorded easement(s) dedicated to the SUD for the purpose of providing reasonable rights of access and use to allow the SUD to construct, maintain, replace, upgrade, parallel, inspect, test and operate any facilities necessary to serve that Customer as well as the SUD's purposes in providing system-wide service for existing or future members.

By execution hereof, the Customer shall guarantee payment of all other rates, fees, and charges due on any account for which said Customer owns. Said guarantee shall pledge any and all Customer Fees against any balance due the SUD. Liquidation of said Customer Fees shall give rise to discontinuance of service under the terms and conditions of the SUD's tariff.

By execution hereof, the Customer agrees that non-compliance with the terms of this agreement by said Customer shall constitute denial or discontinuance of service until such time as the violation is corrected to the satisfaction of the SUD.

Any misrepresentation of the facts by the Customer on any of the pages of this agreement shall result in discontinuance of service pursuant to the terms and conditions of the SUD's tariff.

To all customers of the New Hope Special Utility District:

Cross Connections can contaminate a water system. Untreated water, water from other wells, floats from watering troughs, not installed properly, and pesticides can contaminate your water system.

The TCEQ requests that each system insures there are no cross connections. If a cross connection is found, the health department has the authority to close down the entire system, until the problem is corrected. Definition of Cross-Connection: A physical connection between a public water system and either another supply of unknown or questionable quality, any source which may contain contaminating or polluting substances, or any source of water treated to lesser degree in the treatment process.

- 1. Purpose. New Hope Special Utility District is responsible for protecting the drinking water supply from contamination or pollution which would result from improper plumbing practices. The purpose of this service agreement is to notify each customer of the plumbing restrictions which are in place to provide this protection. The utility enforces these restrictions to ensure the public health and. welfare. Each customer must sign the agreement before New Hope Special Utility District will begin service. In addition, when service to an existing connection has been suspended or terminated, the water system will not re-establish service unless it has a signed copy of this agreement.
- 2. **Plumbing restrictions.** The following unacceptable plumbing practices are prohibited by state regulations.

These potential threats to the public drinking water supply shall be <u>eliminated</u> at the service connection by the installation of an air-gap or a reduced pressure-zone backflow prevention device.
 - c. No connection which allows water to return to public drinking water supply is permitted.
 - d. No pipe or pipe fitting which contains more than 8.0% lead may be used for the installation or repair of plumbing at any connection which provides water for human use.
